

Trump to tackle North Korea on Asia trip

The longest overseas sojourn of his presidency so far takes Donald Trump to five Asian nations to build support for tougher sanctions against North Korea and talk about economics and trade



Nov 3, Hawaii: U.S. *President Trump* visits Pearl Harbor memorial, built over sunken *USS Missouri*

Nov 7, South Korea: Meets President *Moon Jae-in*, delivers speech to National Assembly and visits *Camp Humphreys*, U.S. army base about 65km south of Seoul



Nov 5, Japan: Meets with Prime Minister *Shinzo Abe* and speaks to U.S. and Japanese service members



Nov 8, China: Holds talks with President *Xi Jinping* during state visit

Nov 10, Vietnam: Attends *Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC)* summit in Da Nang, where he is likely to meet with Russian President *Vladimir Putin*



Nov 12-13, Philippines: Participates in Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) summit and meets President

Rodrigo Duterte who has been criticised over extrajudicial killings as part of his crackdown on drug trade

Nov 11: Holds talks with President *Tran Dai Quang* in Hanoi
