▲ **The Millau viaduct, the world's tallest bridge, opened in southern France. The soaring, 343m-high structure spans the Tarn valley in the Massif Central mountains**

1962: The U.S. space probe Mariner II sent back the first close-up pictures of the planet Venus, the first information received from another planet

1967: At Stanford University Arthur Kornberg artificially replicated the DNA of the bacteriophage virus

1995: Serbia, Croatia and Bosnia signed the Bosnia Peace Accord in Paris

2014: Police in Hong Kong cleared pro-democracy protesters from their main camp site after 10 weeks
