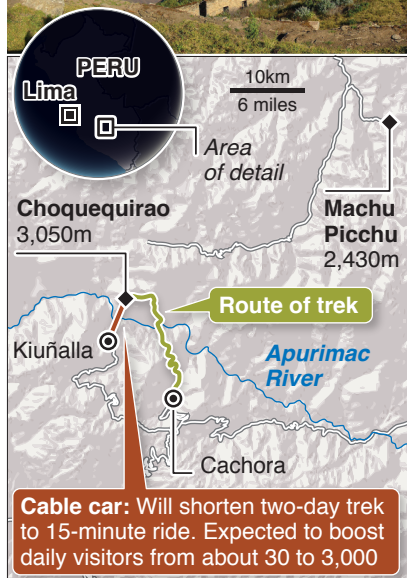


# Choquequirao to boost Peru tourism industry
