▲ The U.S. Supreme Court legalized abortion. The ruling has aroused strong passions on both sides ever since, with the issue as incendiary as gun control

**1905:** Over 200 unarmed workers were killed by troops on “Bloody Sunday”, the start of Russia’s 1905 revolution

**1939:** The uranium atom was split for the first time using the cyclotron at Columbia University in New York

**1973:** Prizefighter George Foreman won the world heavyweight title after knocking out Joe Frazier

**2003:** Scientists in China announced the discovery of a small dinosaur with four wings and plumed tail
