

# Rohingya Muslims killed in Myanmar

At least 6,700 Rohingya Muslims, including 1,200 children, were killed in the first month of a Myanmar army crackdown on rebels in Rakhine state that began in August, according to Médecins Sans Frontières



**Aug 25-Sep 24: Between 9,425 and 13,759 Rohingya died during initial 31 days following start of violence**
