

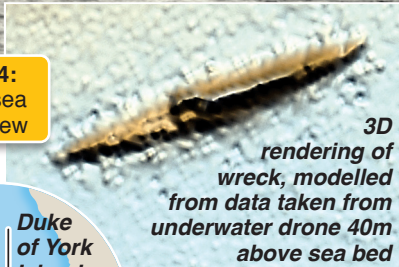
Australia's oldest naval mystery solved

A Royal Australian Navy vessel, the first Allied submarine lost in World War I, has been found after a 103-year search, lying at a depth of 300m off the Duke of York Islands in Papua New Guinea
