

South Korea offers Olympic talks with North

South Korea has proposed high-level talks with rival North Korea to find ways to cooperate on February's Winter Olympics in the South

Panmunjom: Proposed meeting of two Koreas at border village on Jan 9. Would be first formal dialogue since Dec 2015



■ Figure skaters **Ryom Tae-Ok** and **Kim Ju-Sik** (right) are only two North Korean athletes who qualified for PyeongChang Games

■ North has missed official deadline to confirm participation, but skaters could still compete via invitation from International Olympic Committee

■ North Korea has participated in Olympics before, but not in South Korea – it boycotted 1988 Seoul Games. North Korean athletes have won 56 medals in total, but only two from Winter Games
