

Turkey blasts U.S. plan for Syrian border

A U.S. plan to form a 30,000-strong, Kurdish-led border security force in Syria has infuriated Ankara, which is threatening to launch an offensive against Kurdish militia forces in Syria's Afrin region



Turkey: President *Recep Tayyip Erdogan* says U.S. is trying to create “terror army” by training **Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF)**, which are dominated by **People's Protection Units (YPG)** – Kurdish militia Turkey says is allied to larger terrorist group

Turkey could soon launch unilateral military assault against YPG on Afrin canton and possibly Manbij
