JAN 26, 2018, JAPAN *Coincheck* – one of Japan's biggest cryptocurrency exchanges – is hacked, losing 523 million units of its **XEM currency**, belonging to 260,000 customers

FEB 2014, JAPAN *Mt Gox* – world's foremost platform for trading and storing **Bitcoin** – files for bankruptcy protection after 850,000 of its own and its customers' Bitcoins were stolen

NOV 2017, UK *Parity Technologies*, digital wallet developer, finds its multi-signature **Ethereum** wallets are frozen, locking users out of one million **Ether** digital coins

DEC 2017, SLOVENIA Hackers steal around 4,700 **Bitcoin** from *NiceHash* mining service

AUG 2016, HONG KONG Nearly 120,000 **Bitcoin** stolen from exchange platform *Bitfinex*
