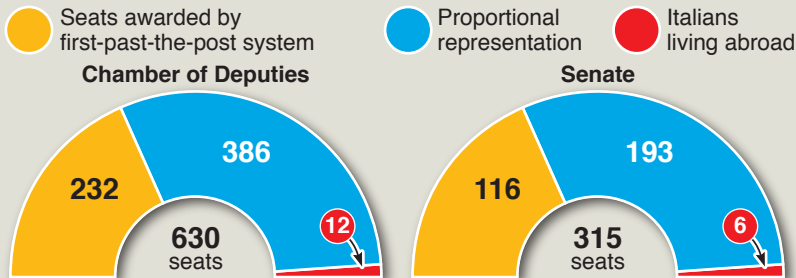


# Italy's revised electoral system

Italy's general election will see the first use of the new "Rosatellum" election law which favours coalitions. Rosatellum mixes a first-past-the-post system and proportional representation



Alliance that wins more than **40%** of votes in proportional system will likely gain over **65%** of first-past-the-post seats – and possible majority

Parties must win **3%** of vote to gain seat. If part of coalition, votes below threshold are transferred to other parties
