February 25, 1948

▲ **President Edvard Benes of Czechoslovakia accepted the resignations of 12 non-Communist ministers as the Communists took control of the government**

1993: Kim Young-sam was sworn in as South Korea's seventh president, and the first civilian president for 32 years

2009: Scientists completed mapping Antarctica's subglacial Gamburtsev Mountain Range, the size of the Alps

2010: Viktor Yanukovych was sworn in as president of Ukraine. He was ousted amid mass protests in February 2014

2014: The largest Bitcoin exchange, Mt. Gox, announced it was filing for bankruptcy following a major theft
