▲ Time magazine was launched in the United States. It has the largest circulation for a weekly news magazine, with a global readership of 26 million

1918: The Treaty of Brest-Litovsk ended hostilities between Germany and Russia in World War One

1933: The likelihood of a scientific link between sunburn and cancer was first made public in Australia

1938: Oil was discovered in Saudi Arabia 16 years after Ibn Saud met mining engineer Frank Holmes

2005: Steve Fossett completed the first solo nonstop round the world flight in his Global Flyer aircraft
