▲ Wimbledon agreed to admit professional players that summer. Rod Laver and Billie Jean King would win the first open era titles at the Championships

1873: The New York Graphic became the first daily newspaper to have illustrations

2008: Ukraine warned that it could divert gas shipments to Europe if its own supplies were cut

2009: President Omar al-Bashir of Sudan was indicted by the International Criminal Court over war crimes in Darfur

2017: U.S. President Donald Trump accused his predecessor Barack Obama of wiretapping Trump Tower
