

Trump to ban “bump stocks”

U.S. President Donald Trump has signed an order to ban bump-stock devices which increase the rate of fire of semi-automatic firearms and were used by a gunman who killed 58 Las Vegas concert-goers last year

■ **Semi-automatic:** One round fired each time trigger is depressed.
Rate of fire limited to speed shooter can squeeze trigger

Bump stock: Sliding shoulder rest replaces rifle's fixed stock and pistol grip and fits over receiver extension (buffer tube)

■ **Automatic:** When trigger is depressed gun fires continuously until magazine is empty. **Rate of fire can reach over 500 RPM**

Buffer tube: Buffer spring uses recoil to recycle bolt, eject spent case and load next round from magazine
