▲ U.S. boxer Sugar Ray Robinson, widely regarded as one of the greatest boxers in history, won the world middleweight title for an unprecedented fifth time

1957: The Treaty of Rome set up the European Economic Community

1995: The world's first user-editable website, WikiWikiWeb, was launched by Ward Cunningham. "Wiki" is the Hawaiian word for quick

1996: More than 100 gay couples were married in a mass ceremony approved by city authorities in San Francisco
