1867: The United States purchased Alaska from Russia for \$7.2 million

2003: New York City imposed a ban on cigarette smoking in all places of employment, restaurants and bars

2010: The Large Hadron Collider shattered records by colliding particle beams at a combined energy of 7 TeV
