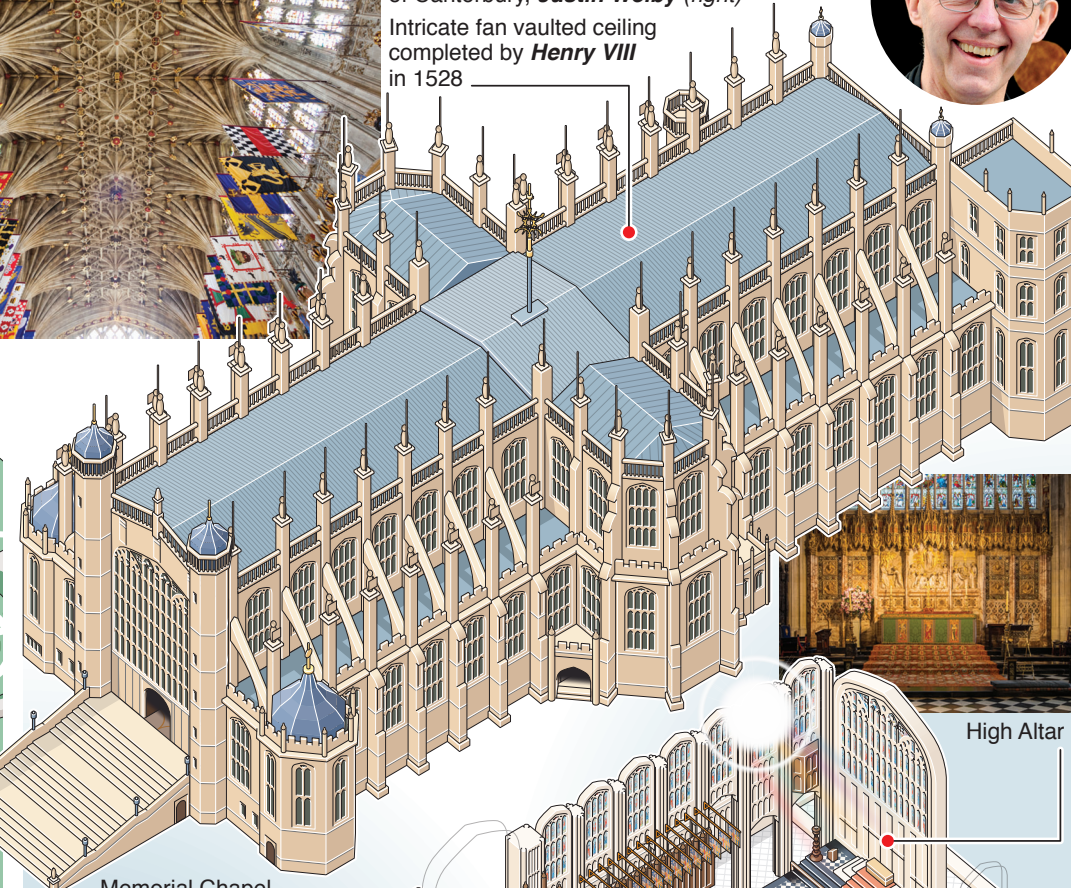
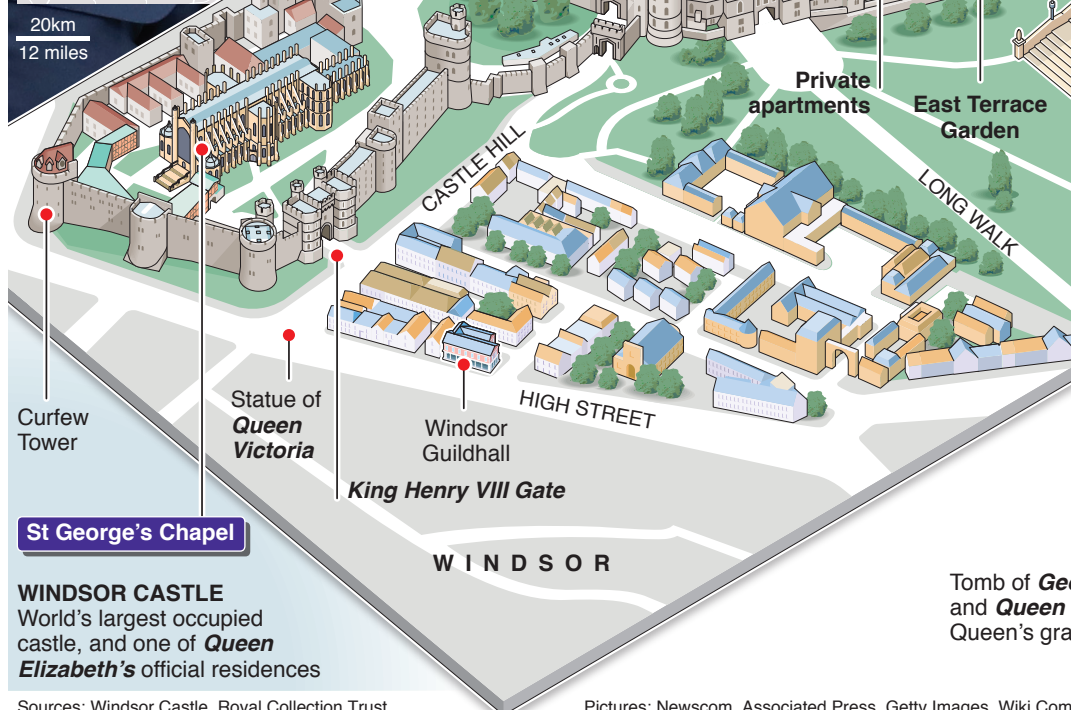
ST GEORGE'S CHAPEL
Among finest examples of Gothic architecture in England. Construction begun by **Edward IV** in 1475



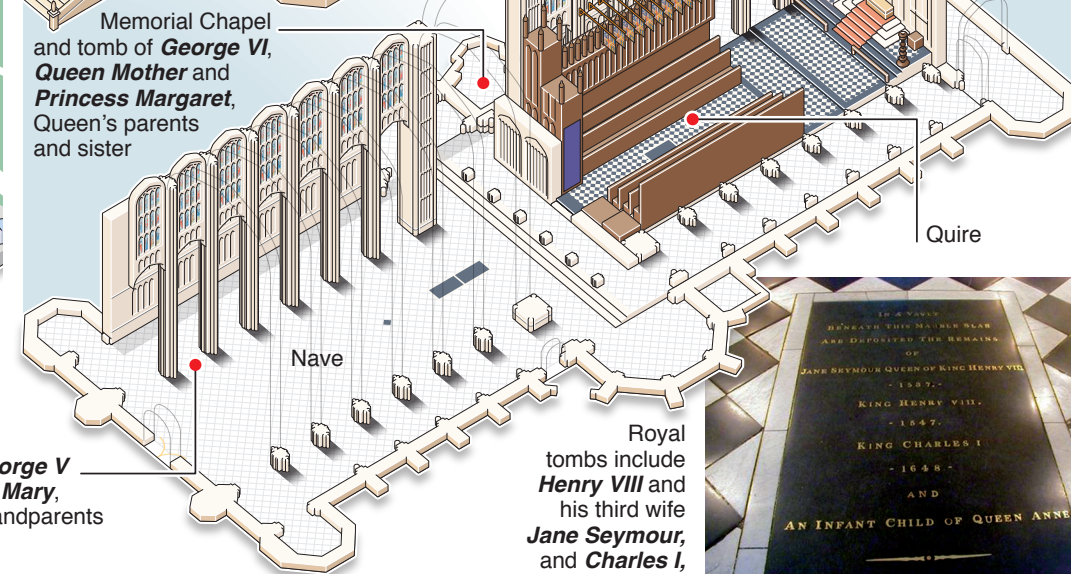
Chapel is spiritual home of **Order of the Garter**, senior order of British chivalry established in 1348 by **Edward III**
