

Catalan leaders wanted in Spain

Spain's Supreme Court has reactivated international arrest warrants for seven Catalan politicians currently living in self-imposed exile



■ **UK:** Former Catalan minister **Clara Ponsatí**, currently teaching at University of St Andrews, Scotland



■ **BELGIUM:** Former cabinet members **Toni Comín**, **Meritxell Serret** and **Lluís Puig**. With Puigdemont and Ponsatí, they fled to Brussels in October after Catalonia declared independence

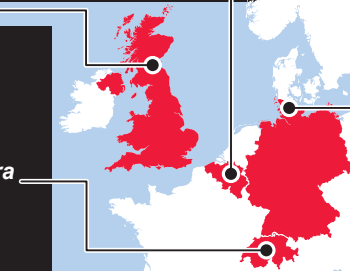
■ **GERMANY:** **Carles Puigdemont** detained by police on Mar 25 while travelling by car from Finland to Belgium



■ **SWITZERLAND:** **Marta Rovira** (left), secretary general of **Republican Left party**, and **Anna Gabriel**, of far-left **Popular Unity Candidacy**

■ **SPAIN:** Supreme Court has ruled that 25 Catalan leaders should be tried for rebellion, embezzlement or disobeying the state

Those held without bail pending trial include **Jordi Turull** – third candidate for vacant Catalan presidency – **Carme Forcadell** – former speaker of Catalan parliament, and **Oriol Junqueras**, former vice-president
