

NATO joins in Russian diplomat expulsions

The Cold War-style expulsion of 150 Russian diplomats is part of a global response by 26 countries and NATO to the Kremlin's alleged role in the use of a nerve agent on British soil

United States: Expelling 60 Russians – 48 are attached to Russian diplomatic missions, 12 are accredited to UN in New York. Russian consulate in Seattle shuttered due to its proximity to submarine base and Boeing

Britain: 23 Russian diplomats and their families were expelled on March 20. London alleges they worked as spies

NATO: Expelling seven diplomats, denies accreditation for three others

Ukraine: 13 Russians expelled

Canada, France, Germany,

Poland: Expelling four diplomats each. Canada also denied three applications by Russian government for additional diplomatic staff

Czech Republic, Lithuania,

Moldova: Expelling three diplomats each. Lithuania to impose sanctions on 21 others. Further 23 banned from entering country

Albania, Australia, Denmark, Italy, Netherlands, Spain: Expelling two diplomats each

Croatia, Estonia, Finland, Hungary, Ireland, Latvia, Macedonia, Norway, Romania, Sweden: Each expelling one diplomat



"Russia's response will be symmetrical"
