▲ According to legend, Saint George, a Roman soldier of Syrian origin, died by order of the Roman emperor Diocletian for failing to recant his Christian faith

**1516:** A regulation in Bavaria specified that beer should be brewed with only three ingredients, water, malt and hops

**1992:** A NASA satellite found evidence of wispy clouds of matter at the edge of the known universe

**2003:** Palestinian president Yasser Arafat and prospective prime minister Mahmoud Abbas agreed a new cabinet after a 10-day stalemate

**2003:** Checkpoints in Nicosia were opened for the first time since 1974
