

# Militant attacks in Indonesia

**2000:** Around 20 people killed across Indonesia in series of co-ordinated bomb attacks on churches over Christmas

**1 2002:** Bombs at nightspots in Bali kill 202 people, mostly tourists, in country's worst-ever terror attack

**2 2003:** Bomb explodes outside Marriott Hotel in capital, Jakarta, killing at least 14 people

**3 2004:** Car bomb kills nine and injures more than 180 outside Australian embassy in Jakarta

**4 2005, May:** Twin bomb blasts kill 22 at market in central Sulawesi town of Tentena

**5 2005, Oct:** Three suicide bombers blow themselves up in Bali restaurants, killing 20

**6 2009:** Twin suicide bomb attacks on Marriott and Ritz-Carlton hotels in Jakarta kill nine people

**7 2016:** Bomb and gun attack in central Jakarta kills four civilians and five attackers – first attack in South East Asia claimed by so-called **Islamic State**

**8 2017:** Suicide attacks kill three policemen at bus station in Jakarta

**9 2018, Feb:** Several people injured in sword attack at church in Yogyakarta

**10 May 10:** Five police officers killed in clashes with Islamist militant prisoners at high security jail near Jakarta

**11 May 13:** Family of six launches suicide attacks on three churches in Surabaya during Sunday services, killing at least 13 people

**12 May 14:** Another family of five carries out suicide bombing at police headquarters in Surabaya. Six civilians and four policemen injured
