

# TANAP to start first gas deliveries

The Trans-Anatolian Pipeline (TANAP) – set to bring Azeri natural gas to Turkey and the EU – is the central link in the so-called Southern Gas Corridor aimed at reducing Europe's reliance on Russian supplies

**June 2018**

Capacity:  
**16bcm** initially  
(6bcm to Turkey,  
10bcm to TAP),  
rising to **31bcm**

### South Caucasus Pipeline (SCP)

Length: **700km**

Operational:  
**2006**

Capacity:  
**7bcm** currently,  
being increased  
to **23bcm**
