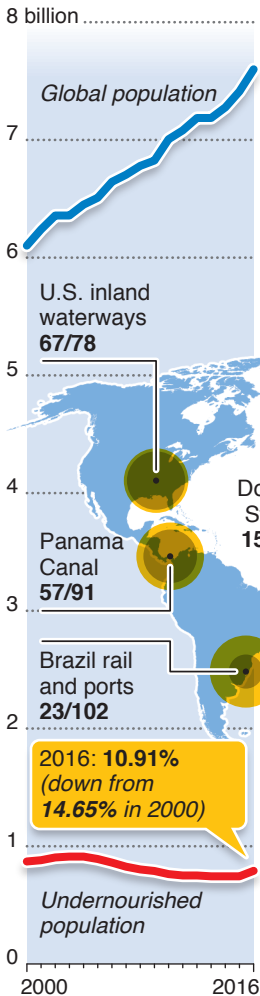


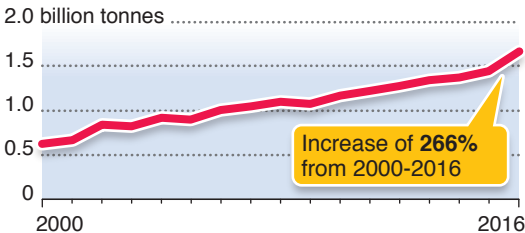
Chokepoints threat to global food trade
