▲ Scientists announced they had found the oldest-known turtle, 240 million years old, that combined traits of lizard-like ancestors with emerging turtle-like features

1994: The world's largest cargo aircraft, the Beluga, was unveiled in Toulouse

1998: Feathered dinosaur fossils found in China supported the theory that birds descended from dinosaurs

2008: Plans were unveiled for the world's first swirling skyscraper in Dubai, with each floor rotating once an hour to form an ever-changing profile
