

# U.S. sanctions hit unlikely victims

America's CAATSA\* legislation applies sanctions on 39 entities in Russia's defence and intelligence sectors, and secondary sanctions on countries engaging in business with them

**India:** Washington is pressing New Delhi to cancel \$4.5 billion

deal with Russia for five S-400 missile systems. Indian armed forces are 70 percent equipped with Soviet or Russian weapons



**China:** Among biggest purchasers of Russian arms, and partner in

major energy projects such as \$9.7bn Gazprom-built **Power of Siberia** gas pipeline



**Indonesia:** Has defied pressure from Washington, signing \$1.1bn order

for 11 Russian-made Su-35s



**Turkey:** NATO member signed \$2.5 billion agreement in December

to buy S-400 air defence systems. Russia's Rosatom is building \$20bn nuclear power station at Akkuyu in Mersin Province



**Vietnam:** Nearly all its military equipment is supplied by Russia.

Washington wants to see Hanoi distance itself from Russia and buy U.S. weapons



**EU:** France's Engie, Austria's OMV, UK-Dutch Royal Dutch Shell and

Germany's Uniper and Wintershall could all suffer penalties because of their part in Russian **Nord Stream 2** gas pipeline
