

# Colombia votes in divisive runoff

Colombia's presidential election is heading into a runoff between two frontrunners from opposite ends of the political spectrum, while a peace process with Marxist rebels hangs in the balance

**Iván Duque, 41**

■ Hardline conservative and former official of Washington-based *InterAmerican Development Bank*, vows to cut business taxes and support private enterprise

■ Ally of former President *Álvaro Uribe*, Duque wants to overhaul 2016 peace deal with FARC rebels by scrapping immunity for those convicted of crimes



PETRO

**Gustavo Petro, 58**

■ Leftwinger and former mayor of Bogotá, pledges to overhaul Colombia's orthodox economic policy and redistribute wealth from rich to poor

■ Former member of long-defunct *M-19* guerrilla movement, Petro, along with three other losing candidates, is committed to peace process
