

Yemen forces poised to take Hodeida port

Pro-government forces in Yemen are closing in on the Red Sea port of Hodeida, the main point of entry for aid to the war-ravaged country, following a rapid advance against Iranian-backed Houthi rebels

Hodeida: Main port for food and humanitarian aid, under partial blockade by coalition naval forces.

Capture could be key to stemming suspected flow of arms and supplies to Houthis from Iran
