▲ **U.S. aviation pioneer Wiley Post became the first person to fly solo around the world, taking seven days, 18 hours and 49 minutes to complete the trip**

1972: The European Economic Community (EEC) and European Free Trade Area (EFTA) agreed on a joint new free trade area

1999: Chinese authorities outlawed the spiritual sect Falun Gong

2010: A new henge was discovered at Stonehenge in England, the biggest discovery at the site in over 50 years

2011: A Norwegian right-wing extremist killed 77 people in central Oslo and on the island of Utoeya
