*July 30, 1793*

▲ The city of Toronto was founded, though it was called York until 1834. Its name likely derives from “tkaronto” – Iroquois for “place where trees stand in water”

**1948:** The world’s first radar station opened at the port of Liverpool

**1993:** British 100m sprinter Linford Christie outran his great rival, American Carl Lewis, at a meet in Gateshead, England

**2003:** The last original-style Volkswagen Beetle, number 21,529,464, rolled off its assembly line in Puebla, Mexico

**2015:** The Afghan Taliban confirmed the death of its leader, Mullah Omar
