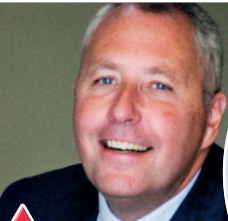
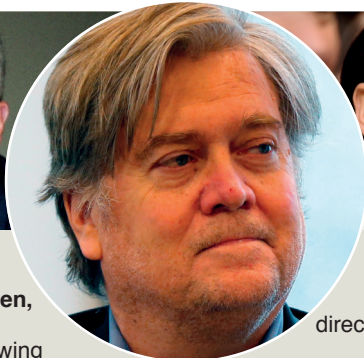


"Movement" to boost EU's far-right

Donald Trump's former strategist Steve Bannon plans to use a Brussels-based foundation named **The Movement** to support populist far-right parties in next spring's European Parliament elections



The Movement:
Founded in 2017 by **Mischaël Modrikamen**, Brussels lawyer, and leader of small right-wing **Popular Party**



Steve Bannon: Believes **The Movement** can unite populist parties and create "supergroup" of right-wingers to win as many as 250 seats in European Parliament



Laure Ferrari: Aide to British MEP **Nigel Farage** (below) and director of **The Movement** with Modrikamen and his wife



European Parliament: Parties grouped around **Farage** and **Marine Le Pen** (left) control 81 MEPs in 751-seat legislature



ENF: Nine parties include Le Pen's **National Rally**, Austrian and Dutch **Freedom Parties**, Belgian **Vlaams Belang** and Italian **League**
