▲ **Muhammad Ali Jinnah, founder of modern Pakistan, died in Karachi at age 71. He led the new nation following partition from India in 1947**

1952: A U.S. surgeon fitted the first artificial aortic valve, made of Flexiglas, into the heart of a 30-year-old patient

1962: The Beatles finished recording their first single, Love Me Do, at Abbey Road studios in London

1968: The first epidural, to ease the pain of childbirth, was carried out

2001: Hijacked aircraft crashed into New York's World Trade Centre and the Pentagon in Washington in the worst terrorist attack in history
