▲ **Bob Dylan became the first songwriter to be awarded the Nobel Prize in Literature, for the poetry of his lyrics “within the great American song tradition”**

1923: Turkey's Grand National Assembly declared Ankara the new capital

1983: The first commercial wireless call using a cellular network was made in Chicago on a Motorola DynaTAC phone

1988: Carbon-dating tests showed that the Turin Shroud, thought to be Christ's burial cloth, was a medieval fake

2010: All 33 Chilean miners trapped underground for 69 days after a cave collapse were winched to safety
