

Japan-U.S. talks to avert car tariffs

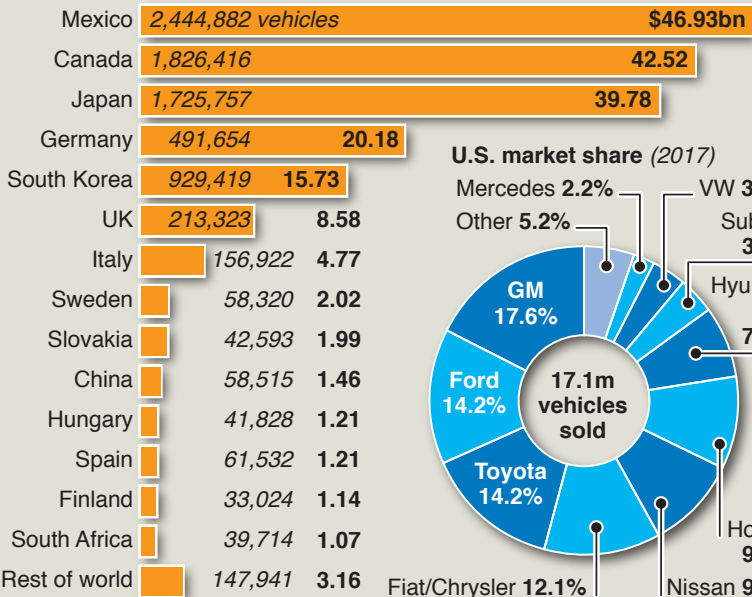

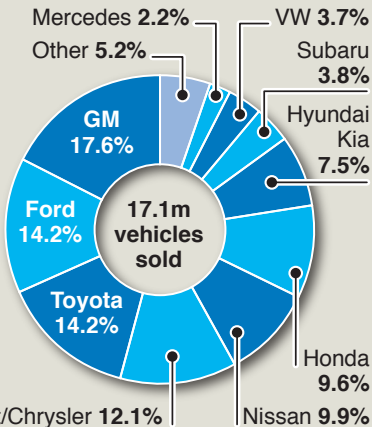
