October 23, 1915

▲ Over 25,000 women marched through New York City to demand the right to vote, the largest such parade yet held. American women finally won the vote in 1920

1958: Russian author Boris Pasternak was awarded the Nobel Prize in Literature for his novel *Doctor Zhivago*

1973: A ceasefire ended the Yom Kippur War between Israel and Syria

2005: Saplings of Wollemi pine, rediscovered in Australia in 1994, went on sale for the first time

2011: Cristina Kirchner was re-elected as President of Argentina, making her the first woman in Latin American history to retain the job
