October 26, 1863

▲ An international conference in Geneva set out the principles which led to the First Geneva Convention and the establishment of the International Red Cross

1863: The Football Association was founded in England by representatives from 11 London clubs

1994: An oil leak in Siberia spread across a large area of fragile tundra

1998: Ecuador and Peru signed a peace treaty that ended years of conflict over their ill-defined borders

2006: The citizens of Kiribati and Tuvalu were warned that they would have to relocate in 10 years because of rising sea levels
