

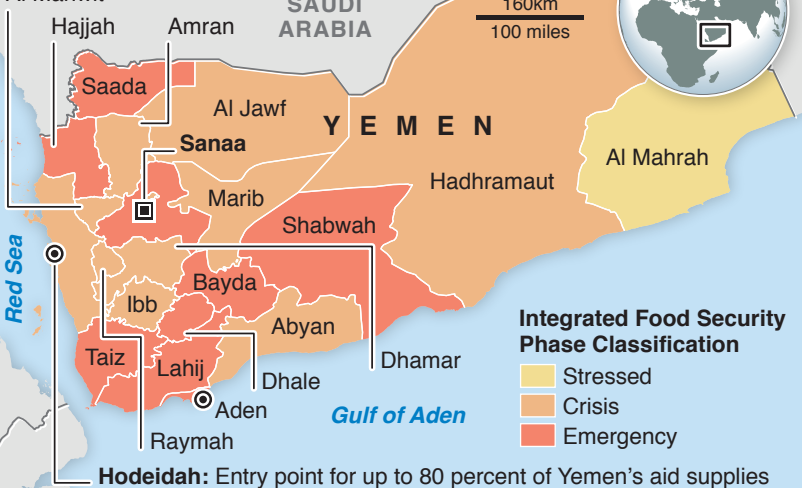
Yemen facing “worst famine in 100 years”

22.2m Number of people in need of humanitarian assistance (75 percent of population)

13m Number of people facing famine and starvation

2.3m Number of internally displaced persons (IDPs), most of them uprooted by conflict since March 2015

16,000 Number of civilian casualties since conflict began – majority caused by airstrikes

78,400 Number of families forced to flee Hodeidah since battle for control of strategic port city began in June 2018
