Caroline Wozniacki *DEN*

Win/loss: **40-15**

Titles: **3**

Won 2017 Tour Finals and then long-awaited first Grand Slam title at Australian Open



Naomi Osaka *JPN*

Win/loss: **42-17**

Titles: **2**

U.S. Open champion at career-high No.4 after breakthrough season. Finals debut



Petra Kvitová *CZE*

Win/loss: **47-14**

Titles: **5**

Champion in 2011. Won Madrid and Doha titles but made little impact in Slams this year



Sloane Stephens *USA*

Win/loss: **33-17**

Titles: **1**

Reached Roland Garros final and won Miami crown – one step below Slam. Finals debut



Elina Svitolina *UKR*

Win/loss: **37-14**

Titles: **3**

Second successive Tour Finals appearance after winning titles in Rome, Brisbane and Dubai



Karolina Plisková *CZE*

Win/loss: **43-19**

Titles: **2**

Consistent if unspectacular season helped secure last berth in Singapore



Kiki Bertens *NED*

Win/loss: **43-19**

Titles: **3**

*First Dutch woman to break into Top 10 since 1996 – replaces injured World No.1 **Simona Halep***
