▲ **Construction of the Kariba High Dam began on the Zambezi River between Zambia and Zimbabwe. It forms Lake Kariba, the world's largest man-made lake by volume**

1928: Jacob Schick patented the first electric razor

1987: General Motors' Sunraycer won the first transcontinental solar-powered car race

2008: Jigme Khesar Namgyel Wangchuck was crowned the fifth King of Bhutan. At 28, he was the world's youngest monarch

2010: The collapse of the House of the Gladiators in Pompeii prompted criticism of the Italian government
