▲ **Anti-Jewish riots took place throughout Nazi Germany. Jewish owned shops were attacked, and it became known as Kristallnacht (Night of Broken Glass)**

1918: Kaiser Wilhelm II of Germany abdicated as the First World War neared its end

1953: Welsh poet Dylan Thomas died in New York, succumbing to whisky and drugs

1989: Jubilant Berliners celebrated the fall of the Berlin Wall

1993: The UN announced that the number of refugees worldwide had risen from 2.5 million in 1973 to 19.7 million
