*November 11, 1918*

▲ The armistice was signed at 11am, ending the First World War. The conflict claimed the lives of around 10 million soldiers and almost as many civilians

**2003:** The EU said it planned retaliatory duties unless the U.S. lifted tariffs on steel imports ruled illegal by the WTO

**2004:** Veteran Palestinian leader Yasser Arafat died in a French military hospital at the age of 75

**2008:** Egypt announced the discovery of a 4,300-year-old pyramid belonging to Queen Sesheshet

**2017:** The Louvre Abu Dhabi opened, the first museum of its kind in the Arab world
