▲ **Australians voted to legalise same-sex marriage, with over 60% in favour. Within a month of the vote parliament passed legislation allowing same-sex couples to wed**

1963: An undersea volcanic eruption created a new island, Surtsey, off the Icelandic coast

1983: The world's then biggest airport opened in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia

1988: The Palestinian National Council endorsed UN resolution 242, implicitly recognising Israel

2008: India's Chandrayaan-1 unmanned lunar exploration mission successfully landed on the moon
