

# Trump's new limo makes foreign debut

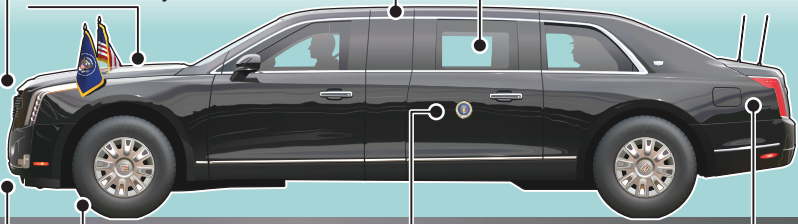
U.S. President Donald Trump's brand new version of the General Motors-built Cadillac limousine nick-named "The Beast" is to make its first trip overseas during Trump's upcoming visit to Paris

■ **Design:** Profile reminiscent of Cadillac **CT6**, features headlights borrowed from **Escalade SUV**

■ **Engine:** Current limo believed to have Duramax 6.6-litre, 300-330hp diesel.  
Fuel economy: 34 litres/100km

■ **Armour:** 125mm thick, capable of withstanding roadside bombs

■ **Interior:** To retain conference-style seating with 2+3+2 configuration. Sealed to counter biochemical attack, oxygen supply in trunk



■ **Tyres:** Special Kevlar-reinforced Goodyear run-flats

■ **Front:** Tear gas cannons and night vision camera inside grille

■ **Doors:** 200mm deep with bullet-proof windows

■ **Fuel tank:** Armour-plated and filled with special foam to prevent explosion in case of direct hit



■ **First aid kit:**  
Includes two pints of blood matching president's type

■ New limo likely to have adjustable suspension to raise ride. In 2011, low underbelly of Obama's limousine got stuck while departing from U.S. embassy in Dublin



■ U.S. Secret Service thought to maintain fleet of 12 similar cars, with each vehicle costing around \$1.5 million

■ **GM was paid total of \$15.8 million to develop vehicle**



■ **Weapons:** Car believed to boast rocket-propelled grenades and pump-action shotguns
