▲ Mickey Mouse made his debut in Walt Disney's movie **Steamboat Willie**, one of the first cartoons with sound. Mickey went on to appear in 130 films

1963: The first telephone with push buttons instead of a rotary dial came into commercial use in the U.S.

1970: West Germany and Poland initialled a treaty recognising the Oder-Neisse line as a common border

1988: A million Serbs protested in Belgrade against ill treatment of Serbs by ethnic Albanians in Kosovo

1993: It was reported that AIDS had become the leading killer for men aged 25-44 in the United States
