▲ **U.S. President John F. Kennedy was assassinated in Dallas, Texas. The gunman, Lee Harvey Oswald, targeted Kennedy's motorcade as it drove through the city**

1943: Leaders of Great Britain, the U.S. and China met in Cairo to discuss the war against Japan

1998: Dr. Jack Kevorkian was charged with murder when a video of a man being given a fatal injection was shown on U.S. television

2001: Pope John Paul II sent the first official papal e-mail

2015: Conservative Mauricio Macri was confirmed as the winner of Argentina's presidential election
