▲ **Pennsylvania Station, then the world's largest rail station, opened in New York. It was demolished in 1963 to make way for the new Madison Square Garden**

1826: English pharmacist John Walker invented the first friction match

1893: A general election was held in New Zealand, the first in the world in which women were allowed to vote

1997: Britain's Meteorological Office warned that global warming could turn off the Gulf Stream, giving Britain an Arctic climate while much of the rest of the world overheated

2005: The first partial human face transplant was carried out in France
