*November 28, 1948*

▲ The first Polaroid camera went on sale. The instant camera used self-developing film to create a chemically developed print shortly after taking the picture

**1994:** A referendum in Norway rejected membership of the EU

**2014:** A previously unknown First Folio of William Shakespeare's plays, dating from 1623, was discovered in France
