



## Today in History

*November 29, 1394*

▲ **Korean ruler Yi Seong-gye, founder of the Joseon Dynasty, moved his capital from Kaesong to Hanyang, now known as Seoul. Yi reigned from 1392 to 1398**

**1890:** The first Imperial Diet was opened in Japan with a House of Peers and a House of Representatives

**1954:** Ellis Island, through which over 20 million immigrants passed into the U.S. from 1892, was closed

**2004:** China signed an agreement with the 10 ASEAN nations, creating the world's largest free trade zone

**2015:** Turkey agreed to help stem the flow of migrants to Europe in return for cash and visas from the EU
