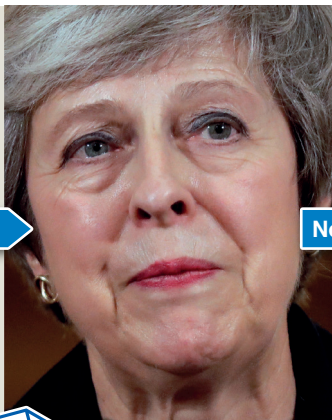


Brexit's rocky road ahead

Tory backbench chief receives letters from 48 Conservative MPs calling for no-confidence vote in **Prime Minister Theresa May**



No-confidence vote

If 159 MPs vote against prime minister – 51% of ballot – May will be removed as leader of Conservative Party

No vote



May wins vote

May loses vote

Nov 25: Prime minister and EU leaders meet to ratify draft Brexit deal

Leadership contest:
New PM likely

Dec: UK parliament votes on draft agreement



Votes "Yes"

Dec 13-14: Brexit deal needs to be backed at **European Council** meeting



Votes "No"

Government has up to 21 days to put forward new plan



Votes "Yes"

2019: European Parliament votes – simple majority needed. EU Council approval by at least 20 of other 27 EU countries

Early 2019
EU Withdrawal Agreement Bill

introduced in British parliament

Votes "No"

Mar 29, 2019: UK leaves EU with no deal, re-negotiates deal, general election or second referendum
