Before its disappearance, submarine reported that water had entered vessel through its snorkel, causing batteries to short circuit

- Nov 8, 2017:** Submarine departs Ushuaia.
- Nov 15:** Submarine vanishes while returning from Ushuaia to its base at Mar del Plata.
- Nov 16, 2018:** Crushed wreckage of ARA San Juan found at depth of 907m by U.S. search firm Ocean Infinity.

- Crushed wreckage of ARA San Juan found at depth of 907m.
- Visible components: Torpedo tubes.
