*December 29, 1938*

▲ A coelacanth, a prehistoric fish previously believed to have been extinct for 65 million years, was caught off the Indian Ocean coast of South Africa

**1933:** Radio Luxembourg, a privately owned French station, broadcast its first commercial programmes in English

**1995:** A French cargo plane became the first aircraft in three years to land at the Bosnian city of Mostar

**1996:** The government of Guatemala signed a peace deal with leftist rebels to end 36 years of civil war

**2013:** Two separate suicide bombings in Russia targeted transport links in Volgograd, killing 34 people
